# Class Descriptions

## K/2 Afternoon Time

K-2 will spend their afternoons with a gentle program that incorporates Scripture, learning through play and movement, time for beautiful art and books, and show and tell. 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade students will also incorporate science studies into their afternoon time.

## K - 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade Movement Essentials

Movement Essentials is a class designed to give students practice in gross motor skills through an introduction to a variety of sports and physical activities.

## 9/10 Introductory Physics

Our high school science program follows a “physics first” model. Introductory physics is a course designed to give all students an introduction to physics, without the vector calculations and trigonometry.

## 7th - 12<sup>th</sup> Grade Foreign Language

Foreign language offerings for this year include Chinese II, Latin II, and Greek Exegesis.
